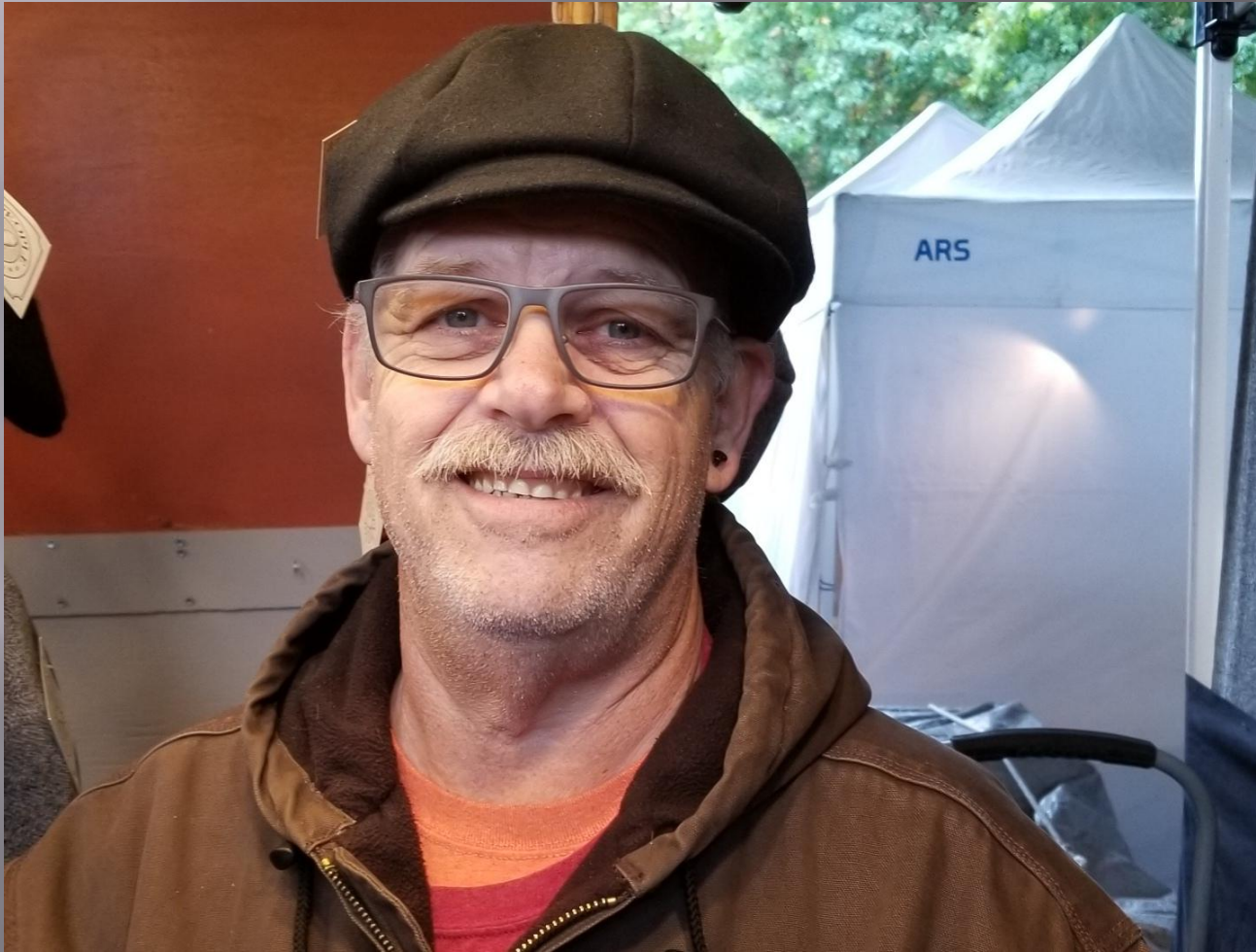

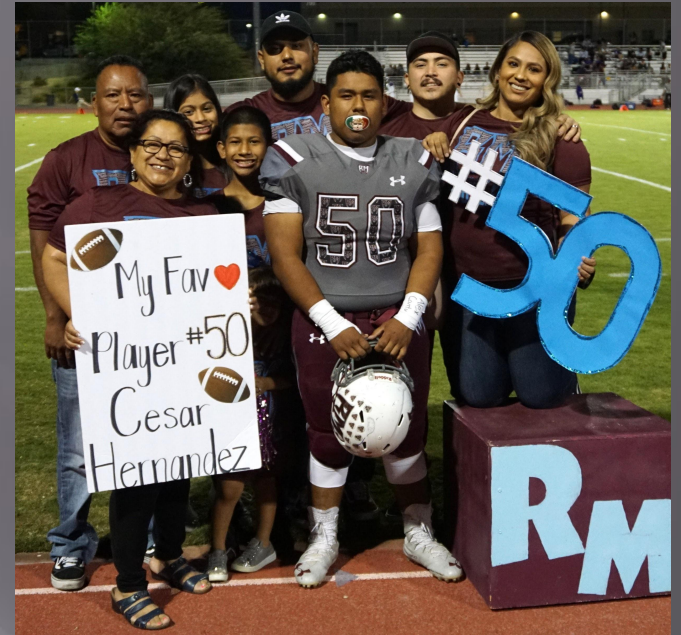

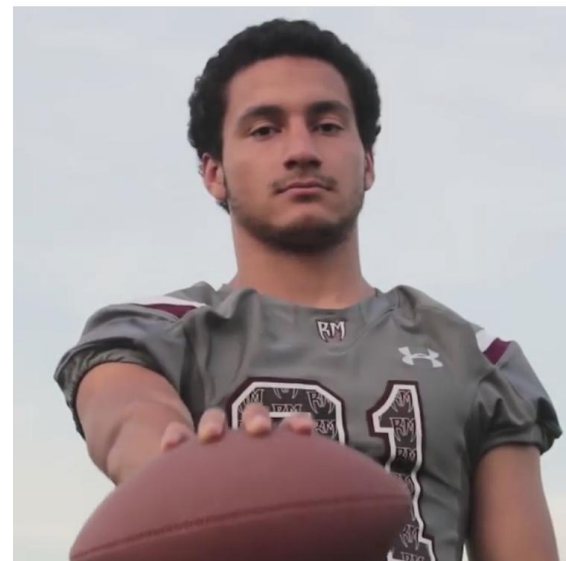

Rattlers take step up in competition

Rancho Mirage expects tougher opponents after league shuffle

With 29 wins in the last three seasons including six playoff victories, Rancho Mirage has been the most consistently successful team in the desert. That might have a lot to do with the Rattlers being No. 1 in the CIF-Southern Section Division poll.

But as desert teams undergo a shuffle in leagues for 2018, it is Rancho Mirage that could be the most interesting team as the changes take effect.

Head coach L.D. Matthews and the Rattlers will take what is perceived as a step up to the new Desert Empire League, something the school has hoped for over the last few years. But that will mean tougher competition just as the school loses Marques Prior, the talented running back who graduated last spring after putting his name in the school's game, single season or career records 44 times.

Expect the Rattlers to try to prove the doubters wrong and expect the team to echo the cry that everyone needs to "step up" for 2018 to be a good year.

Mirage has scheduled non-league games against some of the teams in their new DII, and the overall athletic program has wanted to stand up to get into a league with the best programs in the desert. This is the year the Rattlers move up to play with those teams, and the football team and the entire athletic program is excited by the challenge.

D-backer: A concern heading into the opening of preseason practice, Matthews now believes the back of the defense will be a strength for the team. Corner Cesar Ledesma and Javin Dorsey were starters as sophomores in 2017. Richard Tyler Hernandez and Nathan Campbell move up to the varsity to become the new starting safeties.

Big dogs up front: None of the starting five offensive linemen projected for the Rattlers will be seniors, but that doesn't mean there isn't experience. Nelson Gonzalez, who started all 13 games as a sophomore at guard last year, shifts to center in 2018. Like most coaches, Matthews believes it is what's up front that makes the offense run, and he's confident in this unit.

One reason for concern
Not since the school's first varsity year, when the Rattlers played with no seniors, has the Rancho Mirage team been this young. The squad has just 23 seniors, and only eight of them — four on offense, four on defense — are projected to start. There were sophomore starters on the team last year who return this year, so the experience gap might not be as big as it first seems.

Three players you know

David Talley: Matthews calls Talley a coach on the field, and he expects Talley's leadership and talent to help cushion the loss of Prior. Now a senior, Talley has started 27 games at quarterback for the Rattlers, and he will be the key to an offense that will continue to run an up-tempo option offense.

Mario Montalvo: Another starting senior on a young team, it will be Montalvo's work as linebacker that could help solidify the Rattlers' defense. As a junior, he was one of six Rancho Mirage players named to the all-CIF Division II team, and he's the only one of those six back with the team this year.

Cesar Ledesma: At just 5-foot-6 and 160 pounds, Ledesma might not be the prototypical big cornerback. But he was a starter in 2017 as a sophomore and Matthews describes him as a playmaker who will grab the attention of opposing offenses.

The player you will know soon

The two new safeties: Both Nathan Campbell and Richard Tyler Hernandez are new to the varsity, but they have surprised Matthews with how quickly they have filled voids left from the 2016 season. Both have had in off-season work and developed into players that could make the Rattlers' defensive backfield one of the best in the desert.

"I think we are going to be okay. I think our team will come together. We've got to have some young guys step up. I think they are developing pretty well. It's time for them to step up. We had that same situation last year. We won Coach, we were two sophomore corners playing last year, and we made it to the playoffs," said junior Javin Dorsey.

Best Game

Plenty of choices on a loaded schedule for the Rattlers. The second game against Coachella Valley, which won the De Anza League last year, or the fifth game against powerful Rosemead are contenders. But given the Rattlers have finally made the step up to the new DII, the league opener against La Quinta on Sept. 29 may have the most meaning for the program.

Projected record

5-6, 3-2 DII. Matthews admits he's not that concerned with the five non-league games, as the Rattlers will use them to get experience for a young squad. Two of those games, Citrus Hill and Rosemead, promise to be difficult tasks against powerful teams. Can the Rattlers come together enough by the DII season to cooperate? Even on a young squad, lots of Rancho Mirage players have been important game pieces by winning playoff teams. But the overall record won't be as good as the last three years.

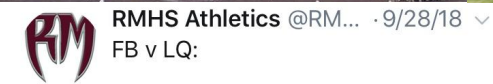

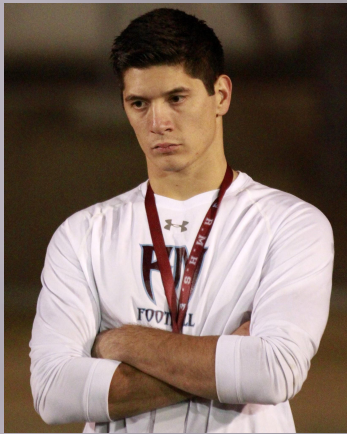

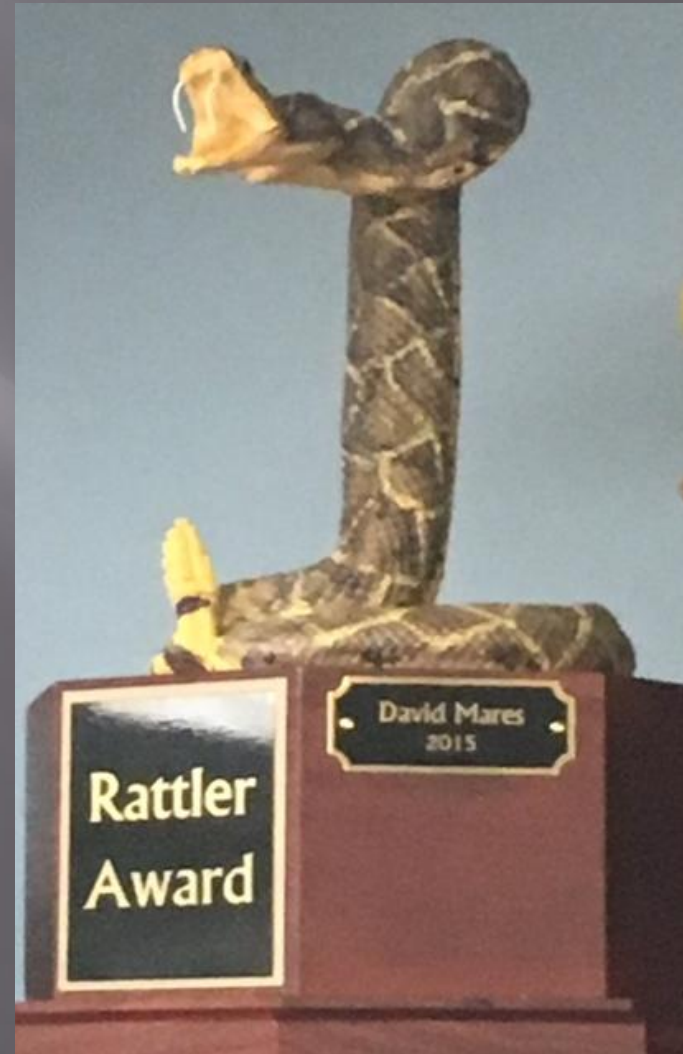
